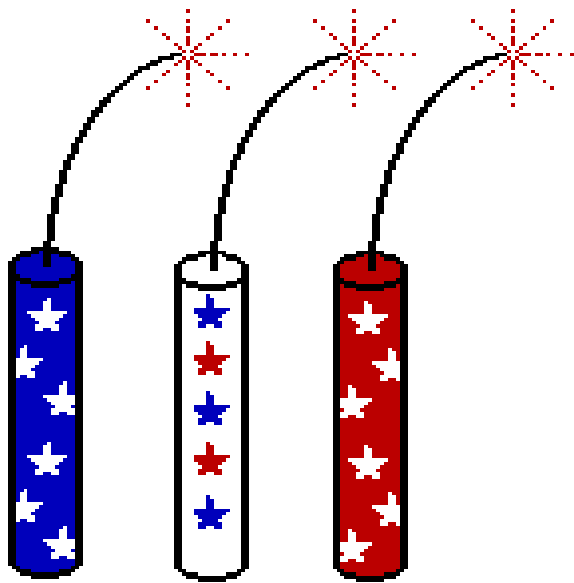

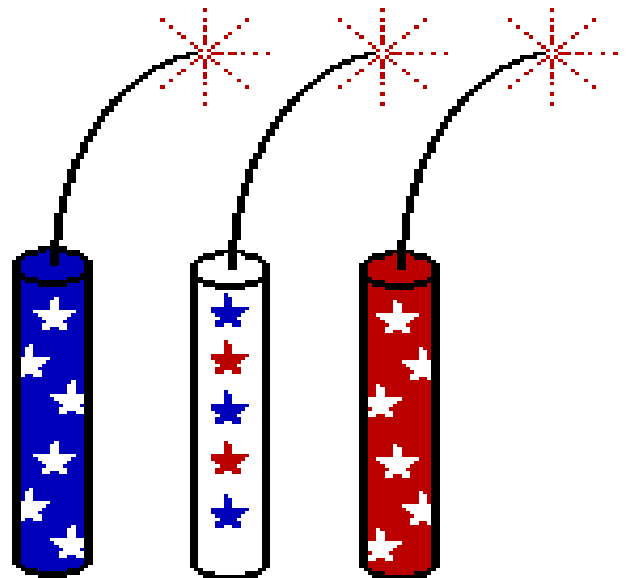

**9:30 A.M. COLOR GUARD**  
**9:45 A.M. FRONTIER DAY PARADE—DOWNTOWN TERRE HAUTE**  
**Monday, July 4th, 2011**

- **ALL** parade participants **MUST** purchase and wear an entry number. **NO exceptions!!**
- Parking/Staging Area will be in the ISU Parking Lots directly across from Hardees restaurant. Parade numbers are available at Boot City, Graham Feed, and Morgan Feeds from June 15 through July 2nd ending at Noon. **Parade numbers will also be available at the parking lot the morning of the parade.**
- The Parade route will be from 4th Street to left on Wabash Avenue past the reviewing stand at 7th & Wabash. At 9th Street, the parade turns left on 9th Street to left on Chestnut to left on 8th Street to left on Eagle Street to right on 9th Street then right on Wabash Avenue and right on 4th Street and return to the ISU parking lots.
- The Sheriff's Department will divert traffic.
- After the parade, everyone proceeds to the Vigo County Fairgrounds on U.S. Hwy 41 for a grand parade awards ceremony, fun and games, plus an open horse show.
- **ENTRY TO FAIRGROUNDS FREE.** The back entrance will be open to the fairgrounds.
- **LUNCH WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FAIRGROUNDS**

**PARADE FORMS AT 9:00 A.M.—MOVES OUT AT 9:45 A.M.**  
**ASSEMBLY POINT— FOURTH STREET & MULBERRY**  
**RULES OF PARADE:**

1. Twenty feet between horses.
2. Color Guards four abreast, others two abreast.
3. Parade Marshal of each club shall be responsible for all riders in his/her section
4. **TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES, RIDERS MUST PARADE DOWNTOWN AND AT FAIRGROUNDS IN THE SAME OUTFIT.**
5. All riders must be suitably dressed in both parades. Please “**Dress to Impress.**”
6. **ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE A NUMBER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE. No Exceptions! Parade numbers are \$ 3.00 each.**
7. The Wabash Valley Horsemen's Association, Inc. does not assume liability for injury to horse, rider, exhibitor or spectator.
8. All horses must remain at a walk or parade gait until you reach point of origin.

**AT FAIRGROUNDS: SPECIAL EVENTS**  
**12:00 P.M. PARADE AWARDS & HORSE SHOW**

Promptly at 12:00 p.m., all participants will parade around the parade field and will be lined up before the judges' stand for review and presentation of parade awards. **To be eligible for awards in parade, entry must have number and be in both downtown parade and the fairgrounds parade wearing the SAME outfit.** Frontier Gal & King of Cowboys are elected on the basis of their past participation and promotion of horse activities in the Wabash Valley. After the awarding of trophies, the fun classes and horse show will take place in the arena.

The **King of Cowboys** and **Frontier Gal** titles are awarded annually to a male and female who have been active in the equine community. They are either active in horse activities, long-time parade participants or have been active supporters/promoters of equine activities or events in the Wabash Valley. To be eligible for the award, they must be riding or driving an equine in the parade. The candidates are selected by nominations prior to July 4th and then win the title by the WVHA Board of Directors majority vote process on Frontier Day. **ALL OTHER PARADE CLASSES ARE JUDGED CATEGORIES OPEN TO ANYONE!!**

To be eligible for an award, entry must have a number and be dressed in the same costume both downtown and at the fairgrounds. No ball caps or T-shirts unless it is part of the costume. Western rider competitors must be in long-sleeved shirts. At awards presentation, you **MUST** be in costume to win the trophy. Registration forms will have a column to indicate the category the entry is competing for, but they may be considered for any award that the costume fits. Judges will have descriptions of the class they are judging. So pick out a category, get out your best boots and hat and come to the Frontier Day Parade. Thanks to all club members, our sponsors and all participants for helping us present the 66th Annual Frontier Day Parade.

## Judged Category Descriptions (awards open to anyone riding in the parade):

- **Best Buggy Hitch:** This award is for horses or mules pulling a buggy. Suitability and likeness favored.
- **Best Comical Hitch or Rider:** This award is for a hitch or rider that amuses and pleases the crowd.
- **Best Dressed Mounted Group—4 or more riders:** This award is for a group of 4 or more riders. Unity and likeness will weigh heavily.
- **Best Dressed Pair:** This award is for any pair dressed alike or to complement each other.
- **Best Dressed Western Show - female rider:** This award is for a female rider. She should represent modern day western pleasure rider. Show tack with silver, show clothes, hat and boots.
- **Best Dressed Western Show - male rider:** This award is for a male rider. He should represent modern day western pleasure rider. Show tack with silver, show clothes, hat and boots.
- **Best Hillbilly:** This award is for a rider of any age. Rider should represent the hillbilly lifestyle (bibs, straw hat, whisky jug, barefoot etc...)
- **Best Hitch 52" and under:** This award is for ponies, donkeys, or minis pulling any type wagon or buggy. Emphasis will be on team unity, likeness, compatibility and harness.
- **Best Hitch over 52":** This award is for horses or mules pulling any type wagon or buggy. Emphasis will be on team unity, likeness, compatibility and harness.
- **Best Indian Rider - female:** This award is for a female rider of any age. This female rider should be dressed in Indian style attire. Horse and rider should look the part if possible.
- **Best Indian Rider - male:** This award is for a male rider of any age. This male rider should be dressed in Indian style attire. Horse and rider should look the part if possible.
- **Best Leadline Rider - Boy or Girl - 10 & under:** This award is for a boy or girl under 10 years old. They can be on a horse or a pony but they must be lead. No t-shirts, sandals, or shorts.
- **Best Mule & Rider - male or female:** This award is for a mule rider of any age male or female. Rider should represent the modern day mule rider. (Western English or frontier person). Rider must have on boots, hat, and no t-shirts.
- **Best Mule Hitch:** This award is for overall attractiveness of a mule hitch pair and buggy.
- **Best Western Pony - under 56" - boy rider 12 & under:** This award is for a boy pony rider 12 and under. He must be in western attire long-sleeved shirt, jeans, boots, and cowboy hat.
- **Best Western Pony - under 56" - girl rider 12 & under:** This award is for a girl pony rider 12 and under. She must be in western attire long-sleeved shirt, jeans, boots, and cowboy hat.
- **Jr. Frontier Gal - 18 & under:** This award is for a girl rider 18 and under. She should be active in 4-H or other hoses activities. She should represent the modern cowgirl/horseman. She must have on show clothes or a long-sleeved shirt, boots, and hat.
- **Jr. King of the Cowboys - 18 & under:** This award is for a boy rider 18 and under. He should be active in 4-H or other hoses activities. He should represent the modern cowboy/horseman. He must have a long-sleeved shirt, boots and hat.
- **Most Original Costume - Mounted:** This award is for a rider of any age. The rider and horse should be dressed in an original costume. Imagination and creativity weight heavily.
- **Most Patriotic Hitch or Rider:** This award is for a rider or hitch of any age. They should be decked out in red, white, & blue.
- **Oldest Rider:** Age verification required
- **Typical Cowboy - 16 & over:** This award is for a male rider 16 and over. Ranch worker attire with no silver a long-sleeved shirt, jeans and a cowboy hat.
- **Typical Cowgirl - 16 & over:** This award is for a female rider 16 and over. Ranch worker attire with no silver a long-sleeved shirt, jeans and a cowboy hat.
