SPONSORSHIPS NEEDED

This will be the 65th year for the Frontier Day Parade held July 5, 2010 in downtown Terre Haute. Each year awards are given for twenty five costume categories worn in the parade as well as a silver belt buckle presented to the King of the Cowboys and the Frontier Gal. The awards are presented beginning at 1:00 pm at the Vigo County Fairgrounds.

Pre-show events include games for all ages both with and without horses. Trophies or ribbons go to the winners of these events. The fourteen-event horse show follows with classes including halter, lead line, walk trot, western pleasure, barrels and poles. Awards and money are given to the winners in these classes.

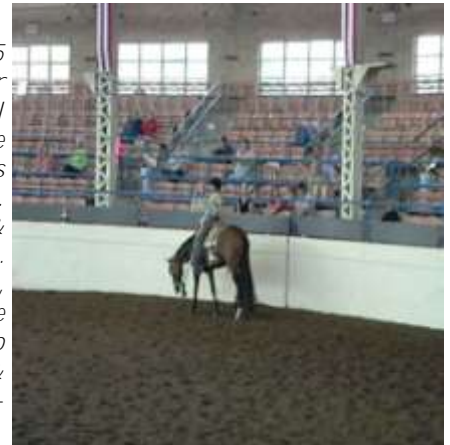
